- ✚ WOLTi's Phoenix program can offer the complementary edge to your residential care service assisting Young People not only being safe and looked after but building a strong start of life with the potential of turning trauma into their strength.
- ✚ The Phoenix program is based in the most in-depth psychological analysis to date aimed at emotional maturity to influence behaviour in a positive way for the present and the rest of their life.
- ✚ You will get reduced incidents of misconduct and violence at the residence locations and in the community.
- ✚ Cooperation with youth workers and therapist will increase significantly.
- ✚ Increased self-sufficiency will show in daily routine.
- ✚ A spark will build up in relation to their natural abilities which can potentially transfer into the basis for paid employment when the time is right.
- ✚ The department of Child Safety supports this program as it fulfils the requirements of service level 3: Access to externally provided support services, assistance with young people's choice and decision making and preservation of social networks. Also training for emotional maturity and transition to independence.
- ✚ The WOLTi's Phoenix program will produce reports supporting your organisation's KPI's contributing to the evidence of success assisting youth development for present and future.
- ✚ WOLTi's Phoenix program supports the findings of the study made by the Queensland Family and Child's commission over the past four years.
- ✚ The program can be delivered at the place of residence or in groups in a community setting adding flexibility to suit your services and young people's routine.
- ✚ Youth workers are welcome to contribute offering support during the facilitation of lessons so they will potentially increase knowledge and ability for youth mentoring.
- ✚ A certificate will be provided to young people when completion of each stage of the training bringing a sense of achievement.
- ✚ The program includes guest speakers from businesses and community to bring awareness to participants
- ✚ We have strong connections with identified indigenous mob they will help with connecting to country
- ✚ Outings can be included if suitable e.g. visit to family, community or employers.
